**Year 6 Revision, Boosters and Home Learning**

Dear Parent/Carer

As you know, the next few weeks are very important for Year 6 as they prepare for the SATS. I thought it would be useful to set out below are plans for this period.

**Morning Work**

As usual, the doors will open at 8.30 in the morning and although we do not insist children are there for this time, over the next four weeks it would be very helpful if Year 6 were in school as close to 8.30 as you can make it. The reason for this is that next week we will begin a review of the home learning that the children did over the holiday and the only time to do this will be 8.30 – 9.00.

**Boosters**

We are also holding specific Booster Groups at 8.30 for invited children only. These children will change from day to day, depending on the area we are covering. We will inform your child the day before if they are invited. We are concentrating on Maths – Arithmetic. If your child is invited, please make every effort to get them to school by 8.30.

**Lessons**

During the day, we are now engaging on a programme of revision of Reading, Writing, Maths, Spelling and Grammar. This means that the days are long and focused. Your children will be tired when they get home. We are keeping 2 hours of P.E. a week, computing and Music in the timetable as well.

**Home Learning**
