

Annual Parental Survey 2021

Many thanks to all of our parents/carers who have participated in our annual survey. 34 parents replied to the survey.

Please find attached a summary of the key points.

Key findings:

- 85% report their child enjoys school (12% neutral)
- 97% report that their child feels safe at school (15% neutral)
- 97% agree the school's response to COVID19 was well executed
- 94% agree school support my child during COVID19
- 94% agree school support my child during COVID19
- 94% agree school's communication in general is useful (6% neutral)

When asked what we should focus on next year

- Online parents evening are helpful (it would be better to have more time)
- Keep coming into school in PE kits (on their day)
- Keep Year Group emails
- Drop off and pick up has worked well
- More awareness of cyber bullying and internet safety
- · Child's Mental Health
- Offer more support for children struggling with English and Maths and similarly, challenge those children who are more able

Communication still needs to be improved (still a lot of late announcements)








5. The school's response to COVID19 was well executed?
