What have we adopted from Prehistoric man?

HISTORY: The topic focus is history.

We will look at chronology and where the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age fit into this. We will explore life in the Stone Age in detail, paying attention to their nomadic lifestyle, farming and burial practises. Iron Age forts will be explored.

English:

Writing: Exploring features of a newspaper Reports and creating their own on a significant event in prehistoric times

Guided Reading: Practising and developing skills of retrieval and interpretation using the text 'Stig of the Dump'.

Maths:

Addition and subtraction of up to 3-digit numbers using formal column methods.

Count in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100. Use known multiplication and division facts to solve problems.

Music:

Explore percussion instruments, practise vocals and take inspiration from tribal music.

WHAT HAVE WE ADOPTED FROM PREHISTORIC MAN?

Computing:

We will be exploring programming animations through Scratch.

Physical Education:

Indoor – Using Real PE we will explore teamwork and social skills.

Outdoor – apply skills learnt into a variety of game situations.

Art & DT:

In Art, we focus on cave paintings including frescos and sculpture. In DT, we will be making Stone Age jewellery.

French:

We will be doing work on colours.

We will learn about Sikhism; in particular the 5K's, the Sikh Khalsa and how it affects their behaviour. We will also look at what belonging means.
