COVID19 Re-opening Plans – parents of Key Worker and Vulnerable children

I wanted to write to you separately as your child has been accessing the school provision for the last few months. Please read this letter alongside the letter(s) to all parents.

Can I continue to access the school provision?

Yes. Key Worker and Vulnerable children are the priority group.

Will school be open full time – Monday to Friday?

Will I need to complete the Parent Survey?

Will it be the same provision?

From the 8th June it will be slightly different.

- They will need to be in a bubble of no more than 15 children
- They will have the same teacher and teaching assistant for the rest of the term
- They will need to wear their school uniform
- Your drop-off time will still be 8:45 and 3:15 for pick up

What if my child is in Nursery, Reception, Year 1?

You can choose whether your child joins their year group 'bubble' or the Key Worker bubble.

If you choose the year group bubble, this will only be open Monday –Thursday. If you choose the Key Worker/Vulnerable Children bubble this will be open full time, Monday – Friday
