Update on Bubbles

We have informed parents on the waiting list that we have been able to open a new Y6 bubble.

Looking carefully at the overall numbers we have decided to open a 3rd Year 6 bubble (growing to a maximum of 15) - this will make a total of 45 places. From Wednesday 1st July, we will have 39 children in school from Year 6, leaving 6 places available. These last few places will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis.
