COVID 19 update

Children will be asked to upload certain work and teachers will acknowledge this. As I have said before, Purple Mash will complement our Home Learning Packs – not replace them.

Expectation of Home Learning

We hope that you are now getting in to a routine with your children, where there is a mixture of educational work, fun activities, down time and family time. We fully recognise the pressures parents/carers are under at this time. It is a difficult time for us all trying to manage working at home and family life. We are here to support you as much as we can and I must reiterate what I have said in earlier letters that there is no expectation for you to complete all the work that we set. We would advise you to look through the pack and choose with your child what is manageable. Use our timetable or set out your own, remembering plenty of breaks and pit stops. Try to balance the day with sitting down activities, individual and family activities and movement activities.

Next week's theme is Arts and Crafts. We hope to see some great imaginative creations by the end of week. Any that you want to upload or send pictures of on Purple Mash or to our home learning email please feel free to do so.

Communicating with Children

We have been investigating ways that we can safely communicate with children face to face. Next week, teachers (Reception – Year 6) will be inviting their class to join them in a Zoom Meeting. This meeting will be approximately 20 – 30 mins long and will be an informal chat so that the teacher can say hello, find out how everyone is and celebrate some of the work the children have done. It will not be a teaching session.

We have set up a timetable for the sessions to enable siblings to join their class at different times. We will email/text you an invitation at the beginning of next week and would ask that a parent is in the room with the child to ensure we are covering any safeguarding issues. We ask that you read the Online Meetings Policy attached to this email and you will be acknowledging your acceptance of these conditions by logging into the Zoom Meeting.
