# COVID19 update 29<sup>th</sup> May

I hope that you are all well, adjusting to the changes to lockdown and managing to enjoy the spring weather. This has been one of our few constants in a very turbulent time and I hope has at least brought some enjoyment over the past few weeks.

As you will be aware we have been working on plans to open the school to additional children from the week beginning Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June. You will have read my previous letter that outlines the basic plans. As with everything at the moment, this is all subject to change with any further government announcements or guidance.

Today we are sending out permission letters for these new groups (bubbles) with more details of final arrangements regarding starting on 8<sup>th</sup> June. We have agreed to open in phases. Phase 1) - will have nine bubbles; **Class bubbles** (Nursery, Reception and Y1) and **Key Worker & Vulnerable children Bubbles** (Infants, Y3, Y4, Y5, Y6). Phase 2) - we will look at opening more bubbles, but have not agreed a specific date. Please contact the school office if you have any questions regarding these arrangements or requesting a place in a bubble.

Unfortunately, we are not able to open a Y6 bubble at this time as the demand for places for Key Worker children has increased and the government have said this is the priority. We hope to be able to do this, and will keep you updated over the next few weeks.

This week has been half term, therefore our Home Learning packs for the week beginning 1<sup>st</sup> June will be available on Monday.

I hope you are continuing to find these packs useful and enjoyable. Just to reassure everyone, that even when we are open on 8<sup>th</sup> June for some year groups we will still, for the time being, be providing Home Learning packs for those children at home. As I have said in previous letters there may come a time, if we open up to more children, when we cannot provide this in the same way, but I will let you know if and when this happens.
