COVID19 Update.

We have sent out a Parents—What-to -do-if Guide. We will use this as the main source of information and update it when needed. Following the Prime Minister's announcement this week we are making a few changes to our procedures to keep everyone safe;

Parents:

- Please wear masks when coming on to the school premises (even the school playground) and office.
- Only one parent to come on to the school premises .
- Please keep to Social Distance rules.
- Park in Aldi or South Hill Park and walk.
- Arrive at your designated time.

Staff

• You may see more staff wearing masks and visors while at drop off, collection and around school. This is particularly for staff who are crossing bubbles such as; Senior Leadership Team, Admin, Catering and Cleaning staff.

Visitors

All visitor are asked to wear a mask—when coming into the office or school.

Reception Parents:

On Monday your child will bring home a 'fun book' - This is a fiction or non-fiction book that your child will return every Friday morning, then independently choose a new book to take home on a Monday. The fun book is not levelled and is not designed to all be read by your child. The idea of the fun book is that you share the love of reading with them and read it with them. The fun book will give your child access to many different genres, characters, stories and non-fiction books to broaden their reading ability.

When your child is ready they will start to bring home a phonics book. This is a book that has been carefully matched to meet the reading ability of your child. A member of staff will change this book when they feel the child can read it fluently and are able to talk about the book and answer questions about it.
