For this trip, we are asking parents to make a voluntary contribution of £13 to cover costs of coach and entrance. Payments can be made online (you will shortly receive a text about this), cash or cheque, payable to Birch Hill Primary School. Please sign the form below, enclose it, with any payment, in a sealed envelope, and return to school, via the class box. Payment and consent forms need to be received by <u>Wednesday 11th March</u>, at the latest. If you have any queries please come in and see your child's class teacher.

We will leave school promptly at 9.30 am and will return to school by 3pm. Your child should arrive at school in full school uniform, though they will need suitable footwear for mud (wellies are allowed). Please supply suitable outdoor clothing as we will be spending most of our time outside.

They will also need to bring a packed lunch or a free Grab Bag (please fill in attached form). Please do not include fizzy drinks or chocolate as it can cause problems with some children on the journey home. If possible please place all of these in one disposable bag (clearly named), as all empty lunch bags will be binned!
