Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you have had a good week and are beginning to look forward to half term.

#### 1:1 meetings

Next week, we will provide Remote Learning packs in the normal way, but will only provide 3 days of live ZOOM sessions. In place of this, teachers will offer 10 minutes 1:1 appointments with children and parents to discuss their Remote Learning. This will only be for children who are at home. These sessions are not Parent Consultation appointments (we will not provide any assessment data or give children targets), however, they will be an informal 'touch-base' meeting to discuss what is working well, celebrate any success and agree any actions for the next half term. We would ask that these 1:1 sessions focus on your child's learning.

Appointments will be sent out on Monday and booked in the normal way - via Teacher2Parents. There will be one ZOOM invite for the whole class, and parents are asked to arrive 1 min before their allocated time, wait in the waiting room, and then teachers will admit you.
