Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope you are all well and beginning to look forward the Easter break and be able to have some quality family time.

Can I remind parents about the importance of COVID19 testing. Please see attached a letter we sent out a few weeks ago from Bracknell Forest. Please remember – Lateral Flow Tests are for asymptomatic testing only. **If you or your child have any COVID symptoms you must book a PCR test.**

The government is recommending that members of a household of school staff or school age children, also take a free twice-weekly lateral flow test. This also applies if you are part of a support or childcare bubble to school age children. Bracknell Forest Council is in the process of setting up Community Collection sites throughout the borough and will announce when these are operational but, in the meantime, these tests are available:

- through your employer if they offer testing to employees
- at a local Community Test Site (see below)
- by collecting a home test kit from Bracknell Leisure Centre
- by ordering a home test kit online (see below)

Car Park

We are aware that the local car park is extremely busy at drop off and collection, this is compounded at the moment with the GP surgery running vaccines clinics. We would strongly encourage parents/carers to either walk, or if driving, park in South Hill Park car park.

Take a test at a Community Testing Site You can take a rapid lateral flow test by booking an appointment at a local Rapid Testing site. Testing at these sites is assisted, which means you will swab yourself under the supervision of a trained operator.
