## **Stage 4 Arrangements**

As per the letter sent on the 9th July that outlines our plans for the expected changes from 19th July.

The main car park will not be manned and the bottom playground gate will not be open. The three pedestrian gates will be open and classroom doors open from 8:30. There will be no one-way system. Registers will close at 8:50 and children arriving after this time will be registered late.

The Nursery will be open from 8:45 to 9:00.

To keep everyone safe, please use the whole staggered time of 8:30 – 8:50. Please note that parents will still need to wear face masks and keep social distance.

Nursery children can be collected between 3:00 – 3:15pm.

Children will exit from the same doors they went in. Nursery and Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children will be released to an adult at 3.15pm.

KS2 children will be released at 3.20pm. Year 3 and Year 4 will need an adult to collect them from school. Year 5 and 6 children may walk home, if we have written permission in place.

Please do not enter the building. Please leave the playground promptly through any of the three gates. Any children not collected will be taken to the office.

We will use these final three days as a trial period and look to see if we need to make any changes ready for September.
