Testing for school households









If you are a member of a household that includes school staff, early years or school age children, you can get a free twice-weekly test. This also applies if you are part of a support or childcare bubble to early years and school age children. This will help to stop the spread of COVID-19 through our community, as one in three people with COVID-19 do not have symptoms.

These tests can be carried out:



through your employer if they offer testing to employees



at a local Community Test Site



by collecting a home test kit from Bracknell Leisure Centre (daily between 1.30pm - 7pm)



by ordering a home test kit at GOV.UK



Secondary school and college pupils	Yes	Twice weekly testing kits provided by school (following initial tests in school)	
Households and support or childcare bubbles of all early years, primary and secondary school and college pupils	Yes	Twice weekly testing through Employer Community Test Site Collection from Bracknell Leisure Centre Ordering for home delivery	
Households and support and childcare bubbles of all early years, primary and secondary school and college staff	Yes	Twice weekly testing through Employer Community Test Site Collection from Bracknell Leisure Centre Ordering for home delivery	
If anyone tests positive or gets COVID-19 symptoms, they should tell the school and:			

get a PCR test to confirm the result	follow the stay at home guidance for households with possible COVID-19 infection. Support is available if you're self-isolating: www.bracknell-forest.gov.uk/coronavirus-
