

Parents/Carers COVID19 Guide

What do I do if.....	Action Needed	Return to School When
My child has COVID19 symptoms <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a new continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours a high temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back 37.8+ a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal 	DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL (If they are in school, we will send them home). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Notify the school of their absence. They will have to self-isolate for 10 days. Arrange to have a coronavirus test. Fellow household members and any support bubble members should self isolate for 14 days, from the day when the first person in the household becomes ill. If any of their household develops symptoms they should request a coronavirus test as soon as possible. Inform the school immediately of the test result. Parents are advised to follow the latest Public Health England (PHE) guidance for households with possible or confirmed coronavirus (COVID-19) infection the test result is negative.
My child tests positive for COVID19	DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Contact the school to tell us. Agree a possible date to return to school. Likely to be 10 days. School to contact PHE / Track and Trace to complete risk assessment. Household contacts will need to self-isolate for the full 14 days, even if they test negative for COVID-19 Anyone in the bubble self isolating to receive Remote Learning. 	After the isolating period. If the child still has a cough or loss of smell, they should return to school as these symptoms can last for a few weeks.
My child tests result is negative	CONTACT THE SCHOOL Discuss when to return to school (same day/next day)	The test results is negative
My child is ill with symptoms NOT linked COVID19	Follow the school normal absence policy/procedures	After 48hrs of the last bout of sickness/diarrhoea if this is the cause of absence
Someone in my household has COVID19 symptoms	DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Contact the school. Self-isolate the whole household for 14 days. 	The test is negative

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Get tested only if you have symptoms. ▪ Inform school of test results. ▪ If child is self-isolating contact the school for remote learning. 	
Someone in my household test positive COVID19	DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Contact the school. ▪ Agree an earliest date for possible return. Minimum period 14 days. ▪ Contact the school for remote learning. 	Child has completed 14 days of isolation
NHS Track & Trace has identified my child has been in close contact with someone with symptoms of confirmed COVID19	DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Contact the school. ▪ Agree an earliest date for possible return. Minimum period 14 days. 	Child has completed 14 days of isolation
We/my child has travelled and has to self-isolate as a period of quarantine	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Do not take unauthorised leave in term time. ▪ Consider quarantine requirements and FCO advice when booking travel. ▪ Returning from a destination where quarantine is needed agree an earliest date for possible return. Minimum period 14 days from return date ▪ Isolate with whole household. 	The quarantine period of 14 days has been completed
We have received medical advice that my child must resume shielding	DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Contact the school. ▪ Shield until you are informed that restrictions are lifted and shielding is paused again. 	School inform you that restrictions have been lifted and your child can return to school
My child's bubble is closed due to a COVID19 outbreak at school	DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Support your child with Remote Learning provided by school. ▪ Your child will need to isolate for 14 days. 	School will inform you when the bubble will be reopened
