

Weekly Update

03 September 2021

Dear Parents/Carers,

It has been lovely seeing all the children come back to school this week and get back into a routine and some sense of normality after so long! Please see below a few reminders (much of this we emailed out on Wednesday).

Drop off and Collection Arrangements (parents to drop and collect at classroom).

All gates open at 8:30. Start time is: Reception - Y6 - 8.50am. Nursery - 8:45 for a 9:00 start. Registration closes at 8:50. After 8:50 children need to go to the office to be signed in.

School finishes at: 3:15pm - Reception - Y2, 3:20pm - KS2

We are no longer using the one way system. Please use all gates when entering and leaving the school grounds.

COVID

While much of a planning will return to pre-pandemic, COVID is still prevalent in the local area and will keep some of these arrangements.

- We are no longer using bubbles and unlikely to send children home. If there are 5 positive cases in a 10 period we will take advice from the DfE
- Children will have lunch in the hall and share playgrounds
- While masks are not compulsory, you may see staff wearing a mask or shield
- Parents and visitors are welcome to wear them
- Welcome Year Group Teacher Meeting (virtual)
- Autumn term Parents Evening (virtual)
- We will continue to minimise visitors and parents coming into school
- In the first instance, meetings should be done virtally
- If you are coming into school we would ask you to wear a mask and remain 2 metre distance
- There will be continued enhanced cleaning regime including a lunchtime clean
- Teachers will begin to plan trips to support the curriculum topics

Guidance on sending children home

- When an individual develops COVID-19 symptoms or has a positive test:
- Pupils, staff and other adults should follow public health advice on when to self-isolate and what to do
- They should not come into school if they have symptoms, have had a positive test result or other reasons requiring them to stay at home due to the risk of them passing on COVID-19 (for example, they are required to quarantine)
- If anyone in school develops COVID-19 symptoms, however mild, we will send them home and they should follow public health advice

Testing

- Staff will be doing lateral flow testing and reporting twice a week
- Staff who test positive will need to self-isolate for 10 days. There could be a significant impact on staff over the autumn term

School Lunches

Lunches are now available to book up until half term for Year 1-Year 6. If you are booking lunches for a Year 3 child, you will now need to pay for these. Lunches cost £2.30 and must be ordered in advance online. Reception children will be able to book after they have been to their stay and play session.
