Dear All,

It has been lovely to see all the children in their dressing up costumes today—there has definitely been lots of fun and laughter. Many thanks to Friends for organising the event and continuing their fund raising events, in particularly the Christmas cards. Any questions please contact us.

Please find attached a letter from the Local Authority and PHE about the recent increase in COVID cases and some new restrictions we are introducing after half term. A summary is below.

Lastly, I hope you all have a restful half term and we look forward to seeing everyone back on Tuesday 2nd November.

The Local Authority and local Public Health team have asked all local schools to reintroduce some COVID restrictions to try and help slow the spread of the virus. We plan to make the changes from the beginning of next half term until at least the end of term.

They have stressed that these need to be proportionate and minimise any disruption to children's education and learning and is NOT a reintroduction of bubbles. Children and staff can go into other year groups. Most trips and enrichment activities (music and sporting events) can still continue.

Restrictions

- Try to avoid/minimise any 'large gatherings' We will continue to use virtual assemblies
- Minimise lunches in the hall & large groups outside—We will put Year 2 Year 6 in their classrooms for lunch and continue with staying in year/phase groups outside
- Minimise Parents in school—We will continue to use virtual meetings and not have volunteers in school
- Reintroduce Face -coverings—Staff will be advised to wear face coverings in communal areas indoors.
- Primary aged children do <u>not</u> need to wear coverings. Parents do <u>not</u> need to wear coverings outside
- We will ask all parents and visitors entering the school including the school reception area to wear a face covering.

Testing

- 7 day daily Lateral Flow Testing—for children with no symptoms
- If someone in the household is positive and the child's PCR test is negative, we will advise you to test you child with a lateral flow test every day for seven days. The child still attends school unless they test positive.
- If your child is Identified as a close-contact, we will advise that you get a PCR test for your child. If the child's PCR test is negative, we will advise you to test you child with a lateral flow test every day for seven days. The child still attends school unless they test positive.

PCR test for children with symptoms

• If your child has any symptoms, they will be advised to get a PCR test, not a lateral flow test. Send test results to covidtest@birchhillprimaryschool.co.uk
