Nursery have been enjoying their outside area despite the changeable weather. We now have a vet's surgery and we are all helping to look after the animals.


The children have also been experimenting with crates, pipes and cars. They were so excited when the cars "jumped" out of the pipes!

We have explored the art style of Paul Klee and produced some wonderful interpretations of his work, sketching first and then using crayons to add colour. We have learned and written some interesting facts about her, and could not believe how she is lucky enough to have two birthdays, or that she doesn't always wear her crown.
