Vocabulary I will learn:	Winter: the season of the year between autumn and spring.Spring: the season of the year between winter and summer.Season: one of the four parts of the year.
	Deciduous: having leaves that fall off.   Evergreen: having green leaves that stay on throughout the year.   Hibernate: to sleep through the winter in a den or burrow to save energy.   Migrate: to change habitat or location.   Adapt: to change for a particular use.   Change: to make different.
	Bud: a growth on a plant that develops into a leaf or flower Blossom: a flower on a tree or bush
