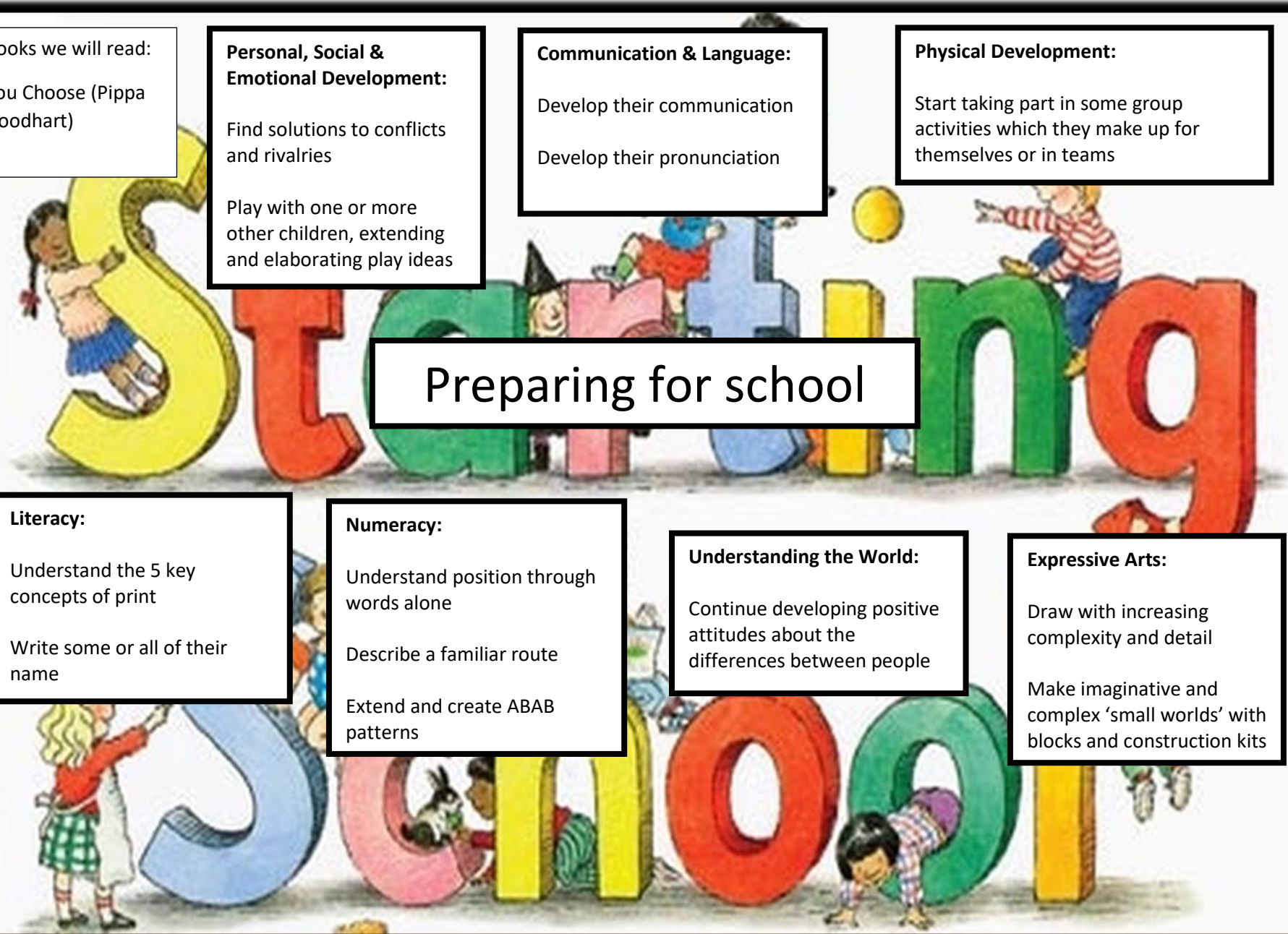

I will learn to play with a group of friends and be able to talk about people in a positive way.</p> <p>I will learn how to describe a familiar route and learn about position words.</p> <p>I will learn how to draw in more detail and also learn how to build more complex small worlds to play with.</p>
