English:

Writing:

Diary writing – An informal account of surviving in the rainforest including quotes from other explorers and portraying emotion.

Guided Reading:

'The Explorer' in conjunction with daily read.

Maths:

Decimal, money and time.

Geography:

Climate and location of the world's tropical rainforest. Develop understanding of maps and compasses. Research layers of the rainforest.

Art:

Study the work of John Dyer who worked in conjunction with Indian Amazonian tribes. Children will take inspiration from body painting to create their own mono print.

Physical Education:
