Where would we be without the ancient Greeks?

September 2022

History:

Children will answer the big question 'Where would we be without the ancient Greeks?' through exploring the legacy of Greek culture. They will complete a study of ancient Greek life whilst exploring how the achievements of the ancient Greeks influenced the western world. Children will learn about ancient Greek art, architecture, literature, philosophy and warfare whilst making comparisons between the city-states.

English:

Writing: Narrative - Myths

Children will be exposed to a variety of Greek myths including 'Ambrus & Cerberus', 'Daedalus and Icarus', 'Theseus and the Minotaur' and 'Pandora's Box'. They will develop an understanding of the features found in Greek myths and apply this to their own myth writing.

Greek Pottery: Children will analyse Greek pottery then design and make their own clay Greek pots.
