How do Life Cycles vary?

Science:

Children will work scientifically by comparing the life cycles of different plants and animals. They develop linguistic skills to enable them to ask pertinent questions whilst suggesting reasons for similarities and differences. Children will go on to observe changes in an animal over a period, comparing how different animals reproduce and grow. Pupils will find out about different types of reproduction, including sexual and asexual reproduction in plants, and sexual reproduction in animals.
