Remember, you may use the computer to produce your project. However, **YOU MAY NOT CUT AND PASTE INFORMATION FROM THE INTERNET.** This project must be your own work.

- Re-read make sure the punctuation, paragraphing, vocabulary is correct.
- Pages numbered and relate to the contents page
- All pictures have captions
