The new class text is 'How to Catch a Star' by Oliver Jeffers and this has sparked their enthusiasm to learn about space and the solar system.


Over the next week we will continue to learn about planets, stars and even pretend to be astronauts heading off on a space journey.

sources helpful. On Thursday 9th February it is the turn of 1M but if you missed this weeks workshop, please feel free to attend.




Take One Picture
