## Year 3 Roman Trip, Chertsey Museum

Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 3 will be visiting **Chertsey Museum** at the start of the Summer term to kick-start our Roman Topic. Our visit will focus on the evidence for lives in Roman Britain and give the children the opportunity to handle real and replica artefacts. The day will be broken up into a variety of crafting sessions, drama, a museum tour and object handling.

Due to the size and layout of the museum, our classes will be attending on two different days:

- 3HD will be visiting on Wednesday 19th April
- 3A will be visiting on Thursday 20th April

We will be departing and returning within school hours.

On your child's trip day, they will be required to bring a **packed lunch** in a named disposable bag that can be binned and a water bottle. If your child usually receives free school dinners and you would like us to order a grab bag, please let us know by **Monday**, **27**<sup>th</sup> **March**. Your child will need to be in school by **8.50am**.

You will also need to fill in the attached Bracknell Forest Consent and Medical Form. **This will need to be completed by Friday 17**<sup>th</sup> **March at the latest.** If you would like a paper copy of this form, please see your child's class teacher.

We are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of £21 to cover the cost of this trip but we are aware that many of you paid money towards the trips that were cancelled last year and in 2020. Payment has been set up online for your child and any monies paid previously is reflected in the amount. If you should have any queries however, please contact the school office.

Please be aware that if we do not receive sufficient funds from the voluntary contributions, the trip will not go ahead as the school cannot fund this trip.

We are very excited to be running this trip for your children it will be a fun and exciting way to start our new topic.
