

Using a computer program of your choice (i.e. paint), draw an animal that lives in a cold place and an animal that lives in a hot place. How have your animals adapted to their environments?




Feeling hungry? Find a tasty recipe and make it! It can be anything from a healthy sandwich to a delicious cupcake.
