Autumn Term 1
What is it made of?

September 2023

Science: The children will be learning to investigate properties of and distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made. They will learn to identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock. This will lead them to describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials and compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.

Maths:

White Rose- Place value and addition and subtraction within 10.

Children will be counting using concrete manipulatives and using the part whole model to complete addition and subtraction number sentences to 10.

English:

We will be continuing to learn the sounds using the scheme of Floppy phonics. We will be focussing on the Traditional Tale of Three Little Pigs and the big bad wolf. The children will be writing a character description of the big bad wolf and using adjectives to describe him. We will retell and write the story of The Three Little Pigs.

Techniques focus: letter formation, finger spaces, forming sentences, capital letters & full stops

Music:

Charanga-Introducing beat

This Unit of Work celebrates a wide range of musical styles. Makes friendships through the power of singing.

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Guided reading:

Three little pigs and alternative versions of the story

Traditional tales-

Three Billy Goats Gruff, Little Red Riding hood, Snow White, Cinderella

Physical Education:

Real PE- Unit 1- Personal Skills- Balance – on 1 leg and coordination.

Unit 2 – Social skills:

Dynamic Balance to Agility- Jumping and Landing

Static balance - seated

D&T:

Designing and building a house using outdoor materials – straw, bricks, sticks.

RE:

Christianity- Creation story. Does God want Christians to look after the world?

Jigsaw: Being me in my world.

We will learn about how we are safe in our classroom environment and we will learn the rules of Year 1 and the classroom. We will learn to be proud of our successes with our learning.
