Year 3	<p><b>I am Learning French</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Map work:- France and other French speaking countries</li> <li>ask and answer, 'How are you?'</li> <li>say, 'Hello' and 'Goodbye'.</li> <li>ask and answer, 'What is your name?'</li> <li>count to 10.</li> <li>say 10 colours.</li> </ul>	<p><b>I can</b></p> <p>Recognise, recall and spell 10 action verbs.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use these verbs in the infinitive to form sentences with 'je peux' (I am able) and 'je ne peux pas' (I am not able).</li> <li>Form longer and more complex sentences using the conjunctions 'et' (and) / 'mais' (but).</li> </ul>	<p><b>Animals</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recognise, recall, and spell up to 10 animals in French with their correct determiners/ indefinite articles.</li> <li>Understand that there are more determiners/ articles in French than in English.</li> <li>Use and become more familiar with the high-frequency 1st person conjugated verb 'je suis' (I am), from the infinitive verb 'être' (to be).</li> </ul>
Year 4	<p><b>Fruits</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Name and recognise up to 10 fruits.</li> <li>Attempt to spell some of these nouns.</li> <li>Ask somebody if they like a particular fruit.</li> <li>Say what fruits they like and dislike.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Je me presente</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Count to 20.</li> <li>Say their name and age.</li> <li>Say hello and goodbye, then ask how somebody is feeling and answer how they are feeling.</li> <li>Tell you where they live.</li> <li>Tell you their nationality and understand basic gender agreement rules.</li> </ul>	<p><b>In Class</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Remember and recall 12 classroom objects with their indefinite article/determiner.</li> <li>Replace an indefinite article/determiner with a possessive adjective.</li> <li>Say and write what they have and do not have in their pencil case.</li> </ul>
Year 5	<p><b>Seasons</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recognise, recall and remember the 4 seasons in French.</li> <li>Recognise, recall and remember a short phrase for each season in French.</li> <li>Say which season is their favourite in French and attempt to say why using the conjunctions 'et' and 'car'.</li> </ul>	<p><b>My Family</b></p> <p>Family members, names and ages.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Count to 100</li> <li>Understand the concept of the possessive adjectives 'mon', 'ma' and 'mes' in French.</li> <li>Move from 1st person singular to 3rd person singular of the two high frequency verbs used in this unit: s'appeler (to be called) and avoir (to have).</li> </ul>	<p><b>My Home</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Say whether they live in a house or an apartment and say where it is.</li> <li>Rooms in the house</li> <li>Ask somebody else in French what rooms they have in their home.</li> <li>create a longer spoken or written passage in French (incorporating personal details such as their name and age).</li> </ul>
Year 6	<p><b>The date</b></p> <p>Repeat and recognise the months of the year</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Birthdays</li> <li>Say the date</li> <li>Create a French calendar.</li> <li>Key dates in the French calendar.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Do you have a pet?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>8 Pet names</li> <li>Tell somebody if they have or do not have a pet.</li> <li>Ask somebody if they have a pet.</li> <li>Tell somebody the name of their pet.</li> <li>create a longer phrase using the conjunctions et ("and") or mais ("but").</li> </ul>	<p><b>Clothes</b></p> <p>Recognise a variety of clothes in French.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use the appropriate genders and articles for these clothes.</li> <li>Use the verb porter in French with increasing confidence.</li> <li>Say what they wear in different weather/situations.</li> <li>Describe clothes in terms of their colour and apply adjectival agreement.</li> <li>Use the possessives with increased accuracy.</li> </ul>
