I accompanied the School Choir when they took part in our third Young Voices event at the O2 Arena, London on Tuesday night



#### **Young Voices**


On Tuesday, The Choir performed at the Young Voices event at London's O2 Arena.

With almost 9,000 children participating every night, Young Voices is a series of concerts that bring together school choirs from all over the UK to become the largest student choral group in the world.

This week Year 1 have been working on their Oracy skills. We had an Oracy assembly and we were discussing the statement 'We are better when we all work together'.

The children really enjoyed talking to their partner or in their trio about the advantages and the disadvantages of working together. Well done Year 1!



#### Year 2

In Year 2 this term, the children have been busy exploring giraffes as part of their fact file writing in English. They have done an extremely good job of including key devices such as subordinating and co-ordinating conjunctions as they begin to extend their writing now we are in Spring 1.

In Maths, we have been learning about money and the children have tackled some challenging questions about counting amounts and finding change! They have also made lots of links about how money is used in our daily lives too.

For topic this term we have been exploring lifecycles with a focus on chickens. The children were very excited to hear that we are expecting chicks for two weeks this term and they will be roped in to look after them.

In music, Year 2 have been learning about beat, rhythm, lyrics and melody. On Wednesday we used glockenspiels and xylophones to practise the melody with the notes C and D.
