Roman Trip - Chertsey Museum

Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 3 will be visiting **Chertsey Museum** at the start of the Summer term to kick-start our Roman Topic. Our visit will focus on the evidence for lives in Roman Britain and give the children the opportunity to handle real and replica artefacts. The day will be broken up into a variety of crafting sessions, drama, a museum tour and object handling.

Due to the size and layout of the museum, our classes will be attending on two different days:

- **3DC** will be visiting on **Wednesday 17th April**
- **3M** will be visiting on **Thursday 18th April**

For this trip, we are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of £22.55 to cover costs of coach, entrance, tour and materials. Payments can be made online, through the Eduspot app. You will also receive a paper Consent and Medical Form, which will need to be completed and returned to school. Children will be required to bring a **packed lunch** in a named disposable bag and a water bottle or select a Grab Bag. Please complete the online form via the link below by Friday 22 March.
