'Make your own maths game' workshop -
Tuesday 25th & Thursday 27th June 2024

Dear Parents,

We are pleased to offer you an opportunity to join your child in school to find out more about how we teach maths and have fun making/playing a game together.

We have booked the Family Learning Team to help run this event - each class will have its own session, starting at **9:00am** and ending by **10:30 latest**.

Resources and equipment are provided and there is no need for the person coming along to be 'good at maths' - it is a great opportunity to discover PRACTICAL ways to support your child's mastery of calculation skills and enjoy some quality 1:1 time with your small person.



CRISS CROSS THREE - SUBTRACTION
 Equipment:
 Red and blue counters (or similar), calculator

How to play:
 Player 1 sets a pair of (blue) numbers from the list to write a subtraction sum on their paper (blueboard). They then need to complete the sum, using their own boards to help if needed. (They might enjoy using a calculator to check their answer too!)
 If the answer is on the grid they can cover it with one of their counters.
 Player 2 then does the same.
 Players take it in turns to choose pairs of numbers and cover squares on the grid. Once a square has been covered it cannot be covered again.
 The winner is the first person to put three counters in a row, across, down or diagonally.
