

How do life cycles vary?

Science:

Children will look at the life cycle of mammals, making comparisons with other animals. They will explore the life processes of plants, insects, amphibians, birds and reptiles. They will learn about the life and works of David Attenborough and Jane Goodall.

English:

Children will explore the craft of persuasive speaking through writing a speech on a subject that they are passionate about. They will learn about how to create a hook and how to engage their listeners amongst other writing features. Alongside this, they will be developing their oracy framework skills, particularly physical, social and emotional.
