**What did the Ancient
Egyptians leave us?**

September 2024

History:

Children will learn about many aspects of life in ancient Egypt including religion, pyramids, pharaohs, inventions, mummification and the life of the people. As well as this, children will develop an understanding of the legacy the Egyptians civilisation left behind.

English:

Writing: Children will write a setting description, with a focus on high level vocabulary and a variety of simple, compound and complex sentences.

Guided Reading:

We will study a non-fiction information text based on Ancient Egypt. We will practise our skills of finding information by using contents, the index and glossaries.

Maths:

Identify, compare and understand angles as measurements of turn. Convert between different units of measure. Plot specified points and draw sides to complete a given polygon. Recognise different angles and explore symmetry. Solve comparison, sum and difference problems using information presented in different types of graphs. Interpret and present discrete and continuous data using different types of graphs.

What did the Ancient Egyptians leave us?

Art:

Exploring Egyptian art, designing, and making a scarab beetle or Egyptian mask.

French

To learn the names of objects around the classroom that the children use on a daily basis eg – glue sticks, books and pens

Computing:

Using a search engine.
Opportunity to research an element of Ancient Egyptian

RE:

Exploring Christian prayer and worship. Learning about the rites of passage within Judaism.

Physical Education:

Outdoor – Athletics
