HISTORY: The topic focus is history. We will look at chronology and where the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age fit into this. We will explore life in the Stone Age in detail, paying attention to their nomadic lifestyle, farming and burial practises. Iron Age forts will be explored.

English:

Writing: Instruction Texts and News Reports – drama.

Guided Reading: Practising and developing skills of retrieval and interpretation using the text ‘Stig of the Dump’.

Maths:

Addition and subtraction of up to 3-digit numbers using formal column methods.

Revise 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Count in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100. Use known multiplication and division facts to solve problems.
