As you are probably aware, now that your child is in school, the school nursing service has taken over responsibility from the Health Visiting service.

Your school nursing team is here to offer health advice and support you regarding your child's physical and emotional health.

Health Questionnaire

This questionnaire is very important as it enables us to identify support we can offer you and your child. The questionnaire will also help us plan the hearing and vision screening that will take place in school during the spring and summer terms. In the meantime, if you have an urgent concern regarding your child's hearing please see your GP and an optician if you have any concerns regarding your child's eyesight.

General themes sometimes emerge from information received from the questionnaire and we may also use this information to plan larger group health promotion sessions in your child's school.
