This exciting event has been organised by several headteachers across Bracknell Forest and is the first of its kind in the area. It promises to be a fantastic opportunity for our **Year 6 pupils** to take part in a range of inspiring and interactive activities.

The day has a strong focus on **teaching children how to keep themselves and others safe** – both now and in the future. Through a variety of hands-on experiences, pupils will explore key aspects of **personal safety, wellbeing, and responsibility**, helping them to develop confidence and awareness in real-life situations.

The event also aims to:

- Inspire children to **dream big about future careers**
- Encourage them to **make choices for a more sustainable future**

A wide range of organisations will be involved, including the **RNLI, Police, St John's Ambulance, Network Rail**, as well as local companies and community groups. Each will be running engaging, practical sessions designed to educate and inspire the children in meaningful ways.

We are also very pleased to welcome some special guests to the event, including **Peter Swallow, MP for Bracknell**, and the **High Sheriff of Berkshire, Sean Taylor**, who will be joining us to meet the children and celebrate this unique community initiative.
