### Year 5 Trip to Chertsey Museum

Dear Parents/Carers

In connection with our topic on the Greeks, we have arranged a trip to Chertsey Museum, for an Ancient Greek Day. Mr O'Brien's class will be visiting on Tuesday 28th January and Miss Mustoe's class on Friday 31st January. Here the children will be taking part in various activities including making terracotta horses, making Greek masks and performing a Greek play. They will be supervised by teachers and teaching assistants.

For this trip, we are asking parents to voluntary contribution the full cost of £15 to cover costs of coach, entrance, workshops and materials. If we do not receive sufficient contributions, then this trip will not be able to go ahead.

Payments can be made online (you will shortly receive a text about this), cash or cheque, payable to Birch Hill Primary School. Please sign the form below, enclose it, with any payment, in a sealed envelope, and return to school, via the class box. You will also need to fill in the attached Bracknell Forest Consent and Medical Form. Forms and payment need to be returned to school, via the class box, by **Friday 17<sup>th</sup> January** at the latest. If you have any queries please come in and see your child's class teacher.

Your child should arrive at school as normal in full school uniform.

They will also need to bring a packed lunch. To make this as authentic as possible Chertsey Museum have suggested some items (see over page).

We will be leaving school at 9.15am and returning before the end of the school day at 3.20pm. A text message will be sent out if there is a significant delay.

No sweets are allowed so please don't give your child any. If your child suffers from travel sickness, please give them suitable medication before they leave home, and send any extra in a sealed envelope with child's name and instructions for taking and hand them to your child's teacher on the morning of the trip.

They **will not** need any extra money on the day.
